

Village of Bartonville Council Meeting Minutes November 27, 2017 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Ricca called the November 27, 2017 meeting to Order at 6 p.m, with roll call.

Present: Trustees Flier, Liebach, Donley, Hoopingarner, and Lawless.

Absent: Trustee Zachman. Quorum present.

Trustees Hoopingarner and Flier motioned to approve the November 13, 2017 Board Minutes and Communications.

TRUSTEE REPORTS

Trustees Flier and Liebach motioned to approve **ORDINANCE # 1770**- An Ordinance to Amend Chapter 46 of the Bartonville Code of Ordinances Regarding Food Vendors.

Trustee Flier suggested that the Board work proactively on raising some of the fee's in the Village fee schedule.

Trustee Lawless requested Board participation in the future reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Trustees discussed leaf burning and other municipalities such as Elmwood picking up leaves. It was stated that there would be no place to put the leaves and it is cost prohibitive to do a pick up.

Trustee Hoopingarner lead a discussion on the Civil Service interviews. It is about a three month process from job posting to interviews and then testing, but the list is good for 2 years.
