

**Village of Bartonville Council Meeting Minutes  
February 25, 2019 6:00 p.m.**

Mayor Ricca called the February 25, 2019 meeting to Order at 6 p.m. with Roll Call.

Present: Trustees Flier, Leibach, Hoopingarner, and Lawless.

Absent: Trustees Zachman and Donley. Quorum present.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Trustees Lawless and Leibach motioned for the approval of the February 11, 2019 Board Minutes and Communications.

Nays: None. Motion approved.

Trustees Hoopingarner and Leibach motioned for the approval of the February 11, 2019 Executive Session Board Minutes.

Ayes: Trustees Flier, Leibach, Hoopingarner, and Lawless

Nays: None. Motion approved.

Trustees Lawless and Flier motioned for the approval of the Expenditures and any Supplementals.

**MAYOR**

Trustee Hoopingarner questioned what Resolution #654 was. Mayor Ricca explained that it was like the previous electricity aggregations that the Village has participated in, except this was for natural gas supply. Multiple municipalities go together to purchase at the best rates. If a resident chooses not to use the supplier that the Village has chosen at the best available rate, they may opt out upon notification from Ameren.

Trustees Hoopingarner and Flier motioned to approve **Resolution #654- A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GAS SUPPLY AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF BARTONVILLE.**

Trustees Hoopingarner and Lawless motioned to approve **Resolution #655- A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY AGREEMENT FOR THE VILLAGE STREET LIGHT ACCOUNTS ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF BARTONVILLE.**

Mayor Ricca spoke of the upcoming Easter Seals closing ceremony at LCHS and that this was a banner year for the school. LCHS is expected to cap a million dollars. Mayor Ricca will be in attendance and encouraged the other Trustees to attend.

**VILLAGE CLERK**

Trustees Lawless and Hoopingarner motioned to approve payment of the Travelers Public Official Bond invoice in the amount of \$3,584.00.

**TRUSTEE REPORTS**

Trustee Hoopingarner spoke of the need to increase the snow ban parking ban fees after reviewing other local communities. The fine amount will now be \$50 if paid one to six days after receipt, \$75 if paid seven to thirteen days of receipt, and \$100 if paid fourteen to thirty days of receipt of ticket. After thirty days, court costs and fines would apply. The need to have cars off the street so Public Works may safely plow curb to curb is critical. Chief Fengel advised Adams Street renters and homeowners to make arrangements with neighbors.

Trustees Hoopingarner and Lawless motioned to approve **Ordinance #1801- AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CH.70 (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES) OF THE VILLAGE OF BARTONVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES (SNOW REMOVAL).**

Trustees Lawless and Hoopingarner motioned to approve the following items:

- a. Conceal and carry/Liquor License/soliciting \$70 each.
- b. Inked fingerprints \$30.00
- c. Schools and Timer Hollis Fire department \$18.00
- d. Resubmission fee \$15.00

Ayes: Trustees Flier, Leibach, Hoopingarner, and Lawless

Nays: None.

Motion approved.

Trustee Hoopingarner thanked Mayor Ricca for some assistance that he provided Trustee Hoopingarner at his residence.

Trustee Lawless spoke of the need for the Building Commission inspector increases after 12-15 years of no change. The proposed increase was described as marginal.

Trustees Lawless and Flier motioned to approve the hourly increase to \$33.00 for residential and \$55.00 for commercial building inspector compensation.
