ORDINANCE NO. 1429

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ISSUANCE OF PERMIT FOR ITINERANT MERCHANT, PEDDLER, HAWKER, AUCTIONEER, IN THE VILLAGE OF BARTONVILLE, ILLINOIS, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bartonville, Illinois, that the Ordinances of 1925 required permits for Itinerant Merchant, Peddler, Hawker, or Auctioneer. and this Ordinance No. 1427 repeals and reinstates permits per the following:

Section 1. FEES AND APPLICATION. The fee for any of the titled permits is hereby established at \$10 per week. The Village Clerk shall issue the permit after the fee and application has been filed with the Office.

Section 2. DEFINITION. For definition purposes, Itinerant Merchant, Peddler, Hawker, shall mean any person who sells food, articles, or property of any kind rendering immediate service to the customer. It does not apply to door-to-door solicitation, door-to-door canvassers, or vendors selling food or convection from a vehicle.

Section 3. CONDUCT. The holder of any permits allowed in this ordinance shall be courteous to all persons, and shall conduct themselves in an orderly and lawful manner.

Section 4. LOCATION. No Itinerant Merchant, Peddler, Hawker shall have any exclusive right to any location on a public street or municipally owned property. For purposes of this ordinance, the judgment of a police officer exercised in good faith shall be deemed conclusive as to whether the site of the seller is congested or the public is impeded or inconvenienced.

Section 5. FINES. Any person, firm, or other entity violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance may be fined not less than \$100, nor more than \$200, for each violation thereof, with each day during or on which such a violation occurs.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
