WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6, provides for the declaration of a state of emergency and the grant of extraordinary authority to the Village President by the corporate authorities; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11, further provides for emergency local disaster declaration by the principal executive officer or his or her interim emergency successor; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Bartonville passed Ordinance 1832 on March 23, 2020- An Ordinance Pertaining to Local State of Emergency and now desires to provide for the exercise of extraordinary powers by executive order during a state of emergency within the Village; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1

The Village of Bartonville shall maintain a Village of Bartonville Volunteer Fire Department "Duty Crew". This "Duty Crew" will consist of a daily crew of 5 Volunteer Fire Department members to physically man the Village of Bartonville Fire Chief assigned station.

ARTICLE 2

Each person that serves on the "Duty Crew" shall be retroactively compensated \$50.00 per day for days served from April 6, 2020.

ARTICLE 3


The use and compensation of the "Duty Crew" shall cease at such a time when the Mayor deems the Local State of Emergency a non-necessity.
